Reader One: The Advent candles burned brightly, drawing our hearts and minds to hope, peace, joy, and love. Now, at last, on Christmas Eve, we light our Christ Candle. This candle is the center of our celebration, just as Christ has a place at the very center of our lives. Jesus Christ is the anchor of our hope, the bringer of true peace, the source of all joy, and the witness of love between family members, neighbors, friends, and those who were formerly enemies. On this day, and all days, we celebrate the gift of God coming into the world, as one of us, to learn and grow and suffer as one of us. In the same way, even as he lived as a full human being, Jesus was the Christ, God's anointed, who had the fullness of God within himself- the power to bring life out of death. We celebrate Christ's birth. We give thanks for Christ's life and resurrection. We rejoice in Christ's presence in the world today. We anticipate the promise of Christ's future, when all will be made new.
